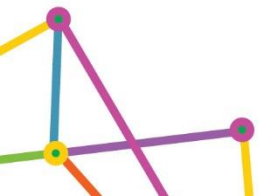

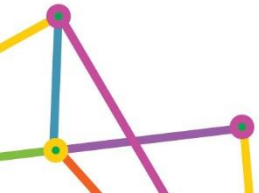
The Primary Health Network Model and WA Primary Health Alliance

The system will provide a uniform data storage solution, underpinned by a data governance model as well as increased analytical reporting capability

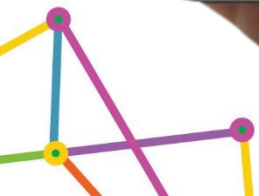

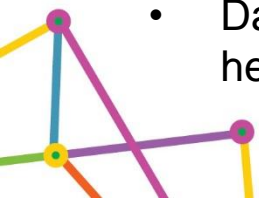


At record creation, 90.4% WA

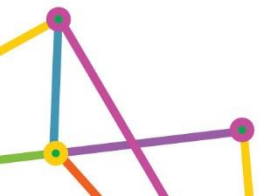


Data Extraction and Analysis

- Subsidises application licences for general practices
- Support in sharing **de-identified** practice data
- Training and support to assist with:
 - analysing data
 - identifying cohorts of patients with specific conditions
 - tracking progress in achieving quality improvement goals
 - understanding new business potential
 - obtaining alerts for missing information at the point of patient contact
- Benchmarking reports to practices
- Data used to support WA Primary Health Alliance's population health planning activities



- Provides GPs with clinical and referral information to assess and manage clinical conditions
- Helps GPs to empower people to take greater responsibility for their own health
- People receive timely and appropriate complex care



GP Urgent Care Clinic Pilot

- Working with WA Department of Health and other key stakeholders
- A webpage is provided by the National Health Services Directory for use by patients to view available appointments across practices in the network
- View “bulk-billing” practices is available
- The webpage integrates with HealthEngine and HotDocs booking systems to support patients with online booking
- Integrating the network with Healthdirect, Australia’s triage service
